Important Notice

Recent federal and provincial changes in immigrant services will result in changes locally to services provided to temporary foreign workers, provincial nominees and permanent residents.

Citizenship Immigration Canada (CIC), Manitoba Immigration and Multiculturalism, Neepawa Immigrant Settlement Services and HyLife Foods Inc. have been working together to minimize the disruption of services to clients and employees while CIC resumes administration of services in the region starting November 1, 2013.

This will mean that effective November 1st, 2013:

- **Any employee of HyLife Foods who are Temporary Foreign Workers or Provincial Nominees will now need to report to their Human Resources Office for any Immigration issues.**
- **Any Temporary Foreign Worker not employed by HyLife Foods will need to contact the Immigration Manitoba Office at 1-800-665-8332, 204-945-2806 or their General Inquiry line at 204-945-6300.**
- **Any Provincial Nominee Worker not employed by HyLife Foods will need to contact the Citizenship Immigration Canada office by calling 1-888-242-2100.**

Anyone who is a Permanent Resident, or has been invited by CIC to present their passports to become a Permanent Resident will have their Integration and Settlement needs performed by Neepawa Immigration Settlement Services.
